

CURRICULUM VITAE DR.SSA GLORIA CAZZANIGA



Gloria Cazzaniga was born on 11th June 1988. She obtained her DDS degree in 2012 at the University of Milan, Milan, Italy. In 2014 she won a scholarship and started the PhD in Oral Sciences at the University of Milan; Professor Eugenio Brambilla is her doctoral tutor. The objective of her PhD project is the study of the interactions between resin-based dental materials and oral biofilms. Her research activity also involves studies related to the physical and mechanical properties of dental materials, the study of microbial biofilms responsible for dental caries and the development of new bioactive and biomimetic dental materials. Since 2012 she supports the educational activity of Professor Brambilla as teaching assistant in Restorative Dentistry at the University of Milan. In 2013 she became tutor at the Restorative Dentistry ward of the IRCCS Galeazzi Institute in Milan. She is Author of articles published on international peer-reviewed journals. She has been honoured with the first award at the congress “Clinica e ricerca in Odontoiatria Restaurativa: la semplificazione” (November 2015) with the research poster “In vitro biofilm formation on resin-based composites after different finishing and polishing procedures”.

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
